○ **How did you come up with the idea for the event?**

The idea of the run came about the enthusiasm of our staff that enjoyed running. The company used to sponsor the staff to run in some of the road races in Guam like the Perimeter relay race and the International PIC Road

○ **Why is the distance in yards not in km or miles like most running events?**

Road races are mostly done in Km and miles but since we are a golf course and golfer measure distances in yards, we decided to put the distance in yards. The distance of the run is 5500 yards which is roughly 5km.

○ **Provide us some details about the course?**

With a lot of races on the same course layout in Tiyan and Tumon, we wanted to provide runners of Guam with a unique opportunity to run on our golf course which is usually not accessible to runners. The run meanders along the best 9-holes of the golf in the Pacific including the infamous 12th Hole. The runners get to see spectacular sunrise in midst of running along beautiful lush greenery of the golf course and the natural beauty of

The course does have some hills but our great volunteers are on the course cheering on the runners and providing water for them. Participants can run, jog or walk. The idea is mainly to enjoy the natural beauty of

○ **Who benefits from the money raised by the event?**

The proceeds of the event benefit the Guam Junior Golf Programs and they are volunteers you will see on the course during the run. In addition all the staff and management also volunteer their time to make this event a

○ **How long have you had this event?**

The first run took place in 2000, we have limited the number of runners to 500. Each year the race has become more popular and we have seen the number of participants increase each year. This will be a special year since this will be the 10th Anniversary of the event.

○ **What can the runners look forward to?**

All runners will receive a race t-shirts, top six finishers in each category receive ribbons for their achievement and 1st place male and female runners receive a trophy which are given out at the after race party where light refreshments are served. Each year we design the t-shirts with a unique designed based on our golf club bag tags. So these will eventually become a collector's item.
